

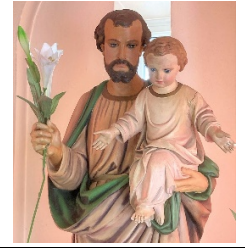

All are welcome to join with the Parish Community,



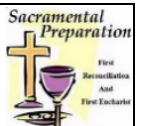

The Mass will take place at St David's Cathedral, Charles Street, at 12.45 pm.

On Saturday 25th May 2024 Archbishop Mark will be holding an Online Open Listening Session via Zoom.

Anyone from the Archdiocese of Cardiff and the Diocese of Menevia is welcome to attend.

The session includes an introduction by Archbishop Mark on why we are considering a union of both the Dioceses of Cardiff and Menevia, some of the challenges and benefits and a brief history of both Dioceses. People will then break into groups (breakout rooms on Zoom) and be asked to consider 3 questions relating to the proposed union of the two Dioceses and about the church in general. Each group will present its findings and the session will conclude with a Q&A session with Archbishop Mark.
